

**UC Davis Administrative Advisory Committee on Child Care
Annual Report 2015 – 2016**

A. Charge

Advises the Associate Vice Chancellor of Human Resources on programs and policies to meet the child care needs of UC Davis students, staff, and faculty; assesses and articulates child care concerns, services, and funding, including the review and evaluation of campus child care activities; and provides a campus forum for child care issues. Committee meets monthly.

D. Achievements and Deliverables

(Actions, projects, events, programs, policies, procedures)

- Advised on process improvements to the UC Davis Child Care Funding Program, begun in 2012-13. There has been a substantial increase in the number of students, both graduate and undergraduate, receiving grants.
- Child Care Grant 15/16 update and review as of May 2016.
 - Graduate Student CCG: \$875,233 awarded. An increase of \$27,241 from 5/2015
 - Community Based CCG: \$457,322 awarded. An increase of \$36,765 from 5/2015
 - TOTAL: \$1, 332,555. An increase of \$64,106 from 5/15
 - 423 students. An increase of 41 students served. Grad/PF: 340 Undergrad: 83
 - 563 total children
 - Of the 340 grad,137 received need-based CBBCG as well as need-blind GSCCG
- Sponsored a campus-wide observance of national [Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day](#) (TODS) for the tenth consecutive year. Signed on six new participating units/departments.
- Established a [Student Parent Resource](#) page on the WorkLife and Wellness website.
- Held the second annual "Family Stuff Swap." The event was planned through a subcommittee from the Women's Resources and Research Center. Many items such as clothes, shoes, books, toys and equipment were "swapped" free of charge for cash-strapped parents.
- Consulted on Post Doc/UAW initiative to improve child care services for Post Docs, including financial assistance modeled on Student Parent Child Care Funding Program.

- Consulted on development of Caregiver Education and Support Program, launched by WorkLife and Wellness in May 2016.
- Changed the name of the committee to “Child and Family Care Administrative Advisory Committee” (CFCAAC) to better reflect the full scope of dependent care issues that face members of the campus community, essentially now including elder care concerns.
- Subcommittee reviewed applications and selected new members for 2016-17.

E. Challenges and Concerns

- Maintaining active participation of members, particularly undergraduate students.
- Broad communication of WorkLife and Wellness news and information.
- Child care center for UCDCM.
- Child care financial assistance for staff.

F. Future Goals

- Development of a child care center for UCDCM.
- Continuing with a yearly educational Brown Bag for parents and the Family Stuff Swap.
